2. A current soil test result for each field. See each policy for specific soil test information. Current soil test must come from an accredited laboratory.

**Policies for Ag Enhancement Program:**

1. Only one application can be submitted per household, farm name or tract number.
2. Field must be crop or pasture currently.
3. **Only eligible for Lime or Fertilizer. (Can submit for both and determine after ranking)**
4. After three years, previously approved acres are eligible for additional lime or fertilizer if new sample result recommends an application.
5. The lime and fertilizer must be purchased and applied by November 1<sup>st</sup> of the following year. No contract extensions will be granted for any reason.
6. **Applicants that received Ag Enhancement Program funding 3 or more times must attend a WCCD or Penn State Extension Ag focused Event in 2026. (Pesticide update meeting does not count)**
7. Applicants that received Ag Enhancement Program funding 5 or more times must have a current ACT 38 NMP or Manure Management Plan and a Conservation Plan or Agricultural E&S plan verified by the district.

**Lime Policy:**

1. A current soil test result for each field. The test is current if it has been taken within three (3) years.
2. Lime Product MUST be Registered Product

**Fertilizer Policy:**

1. For application on grass hay field only.
2. A current soil test result for each field. The test is current if it has been taken within the application year (2026).
3. Soil pH of 6.0 or Higher
4. Meet with Penn State Extension Forage Team after awarded funding to determine fertilizer recommendation and submit yield report from harvested crop.
5. Applying a fertilizer based on soil test recommendations that meets the following requirements:
  - a. No more than 50 units of N per acre per application, unless using or combining with a controlled-release product, which can be applied up to a rate of 100 units per acre per application.
  - b. No more than 100 pounds of K<sub>2</sub>O per application.
